The CDM 2007 Regulations impose different duties and responsibilities to those of CDM 1994 and you need to ensure that you and your organisation are fully aware of the impact of these changes.

The CDM 2007 Objectives were to:

- simplify the Regulations and improve clarity;

Notifiable Construction Projects covered by the CDM 2007 Regulations are those for Non-Domestic Clients which involve construction works lasting longer than 30 days or in excess of 500 person days.
